

MONTROSE COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 1980-5

IMPOSING FEES ON TRASH HAULERS USING
COUNTY DUMPS AND LANDFILLS AND PRO-
HIBITING HAZARDOUS WASTE FROM COUNTY
DUMPS AND LANDFILLS

Be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners
of Montrose County:

1. All commercial trash haulers, municipal trash haulers and all other trash haulers which provide service for more than two households shall pay a fee of \$1.50 per cubic yard of material dumped at county dumps and sanitary landfills.

A. The amount of the fee shall be calculated by measuring the carrying capacity of the hauler's vehicle(s) in cubic yards, and multiplying the volume so determined by \$1.50.

B. All commercial trash haulers under contract with Montrose County to provide collection service for county residents shall be exempt from this fee.

C. Any municipality may have separate rates set by the County for its hauler(s) by entering into an inter-governmental agreement between itself and the Board of County Commissioners. In the absence of such an agreement, the fee shall be determined in the manner provided above for all non-exempt haulers.

2. No hazardous wastes shall be disposed of at any county dump or sanitary landfill, unless it comes within the exception permitted by Federal law or regulation.

A. "Hazardous Wastes" and what are permissible exceptions shall be as defined in the following Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, Subpart C, Section 3000, as amended.

B. If Montrose County does not receive hazardous waste designation as provided by Federal law or regulation, no hazardous wastes, as above defined, shall be disposed of on any county property.

3. Violators of any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$300.00, or be imprisoned in the county jail not less than one (1) day nor more than ten (10) days, or both. The exact penalty to be determined by the Montrose County Ordinance.

The foregoing is the authentic text of Montrose County Ordinance Number 1980-5.

The first reading of said ordinance took place on the 23rd day of December, 1980. It was published in full in the Montrose Daily Press on the 11th day of December, 1980.

It was adopted ~~w/~~without amendments, on the 19th day of January, 1981, and was republished in its entirety (as amended) in the Montrose Daily Press on the 23rd day of January, 1981.
