

RESOLUTION NO. 21 -2015
OF THE
MONTROSE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
CONCERNING: FAA GRANT AGREEMENT PART I - OFFER
TO REHABILITATE RUNWAY F AND ASSOCIATED APRON (DESIGN ONLY)
FOR MONTROSE REGIONAL AIRPORT, MONTROSE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the mission of the US Department of Transportation (“USDOT”) is to “serve the United States by ensuring a ...safe, efficient, accessible, and convenient transportation system that ... enhances the quality of life of the American people, today and into the future...”; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”), a division of USDOT, declared in Title 49 of the United States Code, Subtitle VII, section 47101, Chapter 471, Subchapter I Airport Improvement, effective 2/1/2010 that “...promoting, encouraging, and developing civil aeronautics...” and “enhancing safety and security as the highest priorities in air commerce...” are necessary to the public interest...”; and

WHEREAS, Montrose Regional Airport Taxiway F and associated apron are in need of repair and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, Montrose Regional Airport previously submitted to the FAA a Project Application dated May 4, 2015 for a grant of Federal funds for the project known as Rehabilitate Taxiway F and Associated Apron (design only) for Montrose Regional Airport, Montrose, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is in support of that Project Application for a grant of funds to be used for the purpose of rehabilitating Taxiway F and Associated Apron.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Montrose County Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County, Colorado, as a duly authorized governing body of the grant applicant, hereby formally requests assistance from the US Department of Transportation and Federal Aviation Administration in the form of a US Department of Transportation Airport Improvement Program Grant. The Montrose County Board of County Commissioners agrees that such grant funds shall be solely for aviation purposes, as determined by the US Department of Transportation and Federal Aviation Administration, and as generally described in the Application.

The Board of County Commissioners commits to completing the project without undue delay and to submit formal reports and payment reimbursement requests as described in the Application.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED:

The Montrose County Board of County Commissioners hereby designates Lloyd Arnold as the Project Director, as described in the Manual and authorizes the Project Director to act in all matters relating to the work project proposed in the Application in its behalf, including executions of the grant contract and any amendments.

FURTHER:

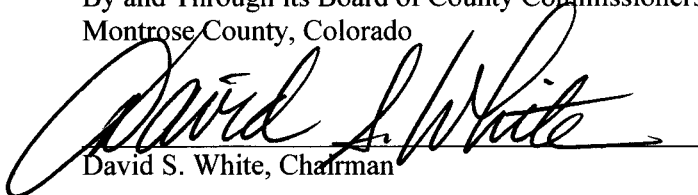

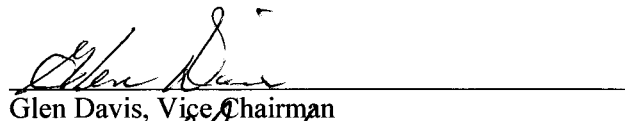
FINALLY:

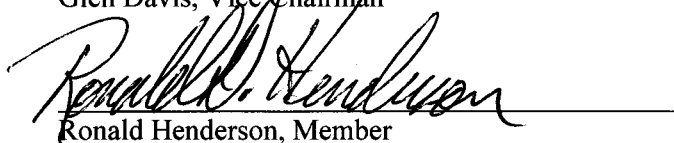
