

RESOLUTION 11 -2012
OF
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
FOR
COUNTY OF MONTROSE, STATE OF COLORADO
CONCERNING PRIMARY ELECTIONS HELD BY MAIL BALLOT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Montrose, State of Colorado (hereinafter "The Board"), pursuant to Article 7.5, Section 104, of Title 1 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, has the authority to decide whether to conduct a Primary Election by mail ballot; and

WHEREAS, a Mail Ballot Election is more cost effective than a Polling Place Election; and

WHEREAS, a Primary Election could be cancelled under certain circumstances pursuant to Article 4, Section 104.5 of Title 1 of the Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Montrose County Clerk and Recorder Francine Tipton-Long has held a comment period as required pursuant to Article 7.5, Section 105(1.5)(b) and Rule 12 of the Secretary of State Election Rules; and

WHEREAS, Montrose County Clerk and Recorder Francine Tipton-Long has made a recommendation to the Board that this 2012 Primary Election should be a Mail Ballot Election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MONTROSE, STATE OF COLORADO:

THAT the June 26, 2012 Primary Election shall be conducted as a mail ballot election, pursuant to Article 7.5 of Title 1 of Colorado Revised Statutes; and

THAT the County's designated election official for such election will be Francine Tipton-Long, Montrose County Clerk and Recorder.
