**Resolution
of
The Board of Montrose County Commissioners
Concerning: Surplus Property Declaration and
Order for Disposal of the Declared Surplus Property**

Whereas, pursuant to C.R.S. 30-11-101(1)(c), each organized county within the state has the power to sell any real or personal property owned by the county and to make such order respecting the same as may be deemed conducive to the interests of the inhabitants; and

Whereas, Montrose County ("County") owns certain personal property described as a Wolf four burner commercial gas oven range with griddle; and,

Whereas, a county of the state, in accordance with C.R.S. 30-11-101(1)(b), has the power to purchase and hold real and personal property for the use of the county; and,

Whereas, the County has no use for the oven due to replacement; therefore must declare the Wolf Gas Range as Surplus County Property and dispose of the Wolf Gas Range in accordance with statutory requirements and County adopted policies and procedures for such disposal and in the best interest of the County's inhabitants; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County, Colorado ("Board"), have determined that consistent procedures should be followed by all Montrose County elected officials, department heads, and staff for the disposal of surplus property; and

Whereas, the Board seeks to assure itself and the public of maximum economies to be achieved through fair and equitable practices as defined under Rule 1-O of the Montrose County Fiscal Rules; and

Whereas, Montrose County fosters effective broad-based competition within the free enterprise system to ensure that the County will dispose of surplus property in the best interest of Montrose County.

Now, Be It Therefore Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County, Colorado that the Wolf Gas Range is hereby declared to be "Surplus Property" of the County, and it is

Ordered that the Wolf Gas Range be disposed through sale in accordance with statutory requirements and County adopted policies and procedures through Notice to the Public requesting sealed bids be delivered to the County Administration Building by 2:00pm on Friday, February 24th.
