of  
The Board of Montrose County Commissioners**

**Concerning: Additions & Deletions of Roads to the County Road Maintenance System**

**Whereas**, the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County have authority under Sections 43-2-109, 43-2-110 and 43-2-111, Colorado Revised Statutes ("C.R.S.") to designate primary and secondary Montrose County public roads and to designate such roads for construction and maintenance; and

**Whereas**, for various reasons maintenance should be extended to some roads and removed from other roads; and

**Whereas**, attached hereto as Exhibit A is a list of Montrose County public roads with designations for changes in maintenance for each road segment under the county road maintenance program accompanied by a location map for reference; and

**Whereas**, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 2020, at 9:30 A.M., the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County held a public hearing, after proper notice, to consider the addition and/or deletion of roads to the County Road Maintenance System as described in the List attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution; and

**Whereas**, the Board has given the opportunity for public input regarding the addition or deletion of maintenance to these roads or road segments; and

**Whereas**, Montrose County is entitled to allocations of Highway Users Tax Funds ("HUTF") from the State of Colorado for use for the construction, maintenance, and repair of road within the county highway system as provided in Section 43-4-207 C.R.S., and Montrose county will submit these changes within their report to the State for the purpose of certifying the 2019 HUTF mileage in accordance with Section 43-2-120(5a) C.R.S. and other applicable law; and

**Whereas**, attached hereto as Exhibit B is documentation to certify roads and mileage to the State of Colorado in support of the HUTF program; and

**Whereas**, any deletions from the County Road Maintenance System or any other action or designation made by this Resolution are not intended to effect an abandonment or vacation of the County's and public's rights in and to said roads, but just a change of maintenance status;

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County, Colorado:

1. That the list specifying and designating roads be added or deleted from the County Road Maintenance program, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby approved and adopted by this Board for the year 2019; and
2. That Exhibit B hereto which certifies Montrose County road miles be accepted with authorization for the Board to sign for submission to the State.
3. That nothing in this Resolution shall be construed or interpreted as an abandonment or vacation of any of the County's rights, title, or interest in the any of the affected public roads.
